# **Return to Thanksgiving Delivery**

The Dimitri House has had a long tradition of offering Thanksgiving Baskets to families in need. This year is no exception. I can share a story that has stuck with me for many years. A young, single mom, parent to an excitable 5-year-old, called to add her name to our list of Thanksgiving recipients. She had recently lost another child in a car accident, and times were tough for her. She felt embarrassed to be needing help with food, sad about her lack of finances, and wishing she could make her 5-year-old happy with a treat (specifically, a cake) for their Thanksgiving dinner. I made a note on her application regarding the "cake." As it happened, the day I was due to deliver her Thanksgiving meal and supplies, a local bakery had donated a number of pumpkin pies, apple pies... and one chocolate cake. I added that cake to my bags of food, resting it right on the top. I made my way over to their residence. Their apartment was on the second floor of the building, up a very steep flight of stairs. The mom came down to help me with the groceries, telling her child to stay at the top of the stairs. We unloaded a few boxes, and then as I brought the last bag into the entryway, the 5-year-old screamed out loud, "YOU GOT CAKE!!!!!" The mother was so moved that I had remembered that detail, she gave me the biggest hug that lasted several minutes.

Stories like these were common prior to our COVID-safe restrictions, whereby donors were matched with a specific family and delivered their turkey and the fixings directly to the family's residence. The last two years, we adapted our programming in order to maintain social distancing to keep our donors and our clients safe. This year we are hopeful that our donors will consider returning to our direct delivery model. By this format, donors will connect directly with the family in need that they will sponsor and coordinate together to schedule a time for their Thanksgiving Basket delivery. Not only does this enable us to serve more families in need due to our limited storage capabilities here at the Dimitri House, it also embodies the true spirit of the season by connecting those we serve with those who enable us to do so! With the help of our dedicated donors, we were able to serve more than 300 families in the Rochester area with a complete Thanksgiving meal in 2021. # What's Happening at Dimitri House?

#### CALL FOR BOARD MEMBERS

I was introduced to Dimitri House over 30 years ago as it was one of the many outreach ministries of Corpus Christi Church. Initially I volunteered at the overnight men's shelter. Staying in the shelter 1 night a month, between November to March, I got to know the homeless men who called Dimitri House 'home'. "Why?" - I would often ask myself - 'are these men homeless?' What unfortunate circumstance led them to this point? For some, it was an addiction, for others, a lost job, or no family safety net put them on the streets. I felt honored to help house, feed, and offer hospitality for those few hours before the men went to sleep. Soon afterwards, I offered my database skills to help with scheduling volunteers for the shelter. As I used these skills to help the volunteer organization, little did I realize my corporate skills were the foundation of my future contributions to Dimitri House.

One day Bob Campbell, a sitting Dimitri House Board Member and personal friend, said to me, "Gene, you'd be a great asset to Dimitri House's board - would you consider joining?" I never pictured myself a 'board member' as I thought about Bob's proposal. What might this 'opportunity' entail? I met with the board chair, sat in on one of the board meetings, and realized I could contribute my skills to help Dimitri House achieve its mission.

Today, eight years later, I am helping to shape the future strategic direction of Dimitri House/Mamczur Place. I have learned what it takes to run a not-forprofit, exercised skills I had, and acquired new skills along the way.

#### MAMCZUR PLACE UPDATE

The Mamczur Place Apartments at Dimitri House, our permanent supportive housing program, celebrated its one year anniversary of opening in May of this year. To say this novel endeavor has been a success is an understatement!

To date, we have successfully housed six formerly homeless individuals, noting improvements for these folks in a multitude of circumstances, including family reunification, life skills, maintaining sobriety, mental health, physical health, socialization, and overall stablity. One of our tenants has even secured a full time to job to support themselves!

With the supports of Dimitri House's programs just a few feet away, such as our Emergency Food Cupboard and Drop-In Lunch program, and intensive onsite case management, our Mamczur Place superstars are set up to flourish - and they are thriving!

#### THE FIRST ANNUAL CHICKEN BBQ WAS A HIT

On a gorgeous Friday evening in June, the Dimitri House team took on a fundraising event we have never tried before - our first chicken BBQ! The results exceeded our expectations, selling 208 chicken dinners and raising a grand total of \$2,000 through your generous donations to support our Dimitri House programs.
